Mission and Project Summary:

The aim of this project is training a puppy to become an Autism Dog for a child with ASD (Autism Spectrum Disorder) in order to help him to develop its potential and achieve as much independence as possible.

A fully trained autism dog helps with: introducing daily routines, reducing bolting behavior, reducing stress and anxiety in unknown situations and environments, improving sleep, quitting repetitive behavior, ...

Given that the autism dog has access to public places, the family can do things that were previously impossible (grocery shopping, going on holiday,...). The autism dog gives the parents and the child greater independence and creates a safe environment for the child

Mission and Project Summary:

Given the increasing difficulty for young musicians and composers to successfully pursue a career in classical music, and the lack of musical interest with younger generations, Euterpe VZW acts as a matchmaker by providing top-level concerts at minimum costs, thereby offering sufficient resources for young musicians and composers at the beginning of their career, and simultaneously attracting a young audience whose ears are made sensitive to the world of classical music. Since the covid-19 pandemic has proven especially hard for classical concerts, Euterpe VZW plans a series of concerts under the common denominator “young is unloved”, a twist to the saying “unknown often means unloved” (in French: “on aime peu ce qui nous est inconnu”). By specifically targeting young audiences, we stimulate their appetite by drawing them to this important cultural heritage

Mission and Project Summary:

The aim of this project is to provide French language classes for migrant mothers and provide childcare at the same time as the classes. It aims to contribute to the integration of migrant mothers in Belgium. As traditional language classes are not suitable for mothers, because of childcare and housework, LLM provides tailor-made support for them to be able to gain the tools for their integration and socio-professional empowerment. The classes running twice a week from 16h30 to 18h30.

Mission and Project Summary:

Building a water supply infrastructure in the children's garden (for the moment it comes from a local provider, but often insufficient supply during several hours a day or even several days in a row). Consists out of: digging a borehole, installing a water pump, solar panels, and building a tower stand with the water tanks, piping and several distribution points. Water will be used for cooking, cleaning, gardening, rinsing toilets. By installing extra distribution points in the Bamelang area also children, babies and their families will have fresh water.

Mission and Project Summary:

The aim of this project is to renovate the outdated sanitary facilities. They want to choose for wall hung toilets, urinals with auto flush and a walk-in shower for people who do not have enough infrastructure in their home situation to satisfy basic hygiene. They also want to provide a pipe to connect the sanitary facilities to rainwater in the future

Mission and Project Summary:

Charity: founded by the parents of Colette a 5 year old girl suffering from Cerebral Palsy. Cerebral palsy (CP): a part of the brain does not work, symptoms permanent movement disorders, poor coordination, stiff muscles, weak muscles, and tremors. There may be problems with sensation, vision, hearing, swallowing, and speaking. In 80% of the cases they suffer from epileptic due to the brain damage. .

Project: Offering relaxing moments to the families of CP children, a peace moment that the complete family (also brothers and sisters) with a CP child often desperately need in form of a pleasant time. A moment away from doctors, therapy, hospital, surgeries, ... An experience consists out of, feeding, feeling, hearing, cuddling, and a medal at the end of the session. The stimuli have a huge positive influence.

Target and number of beneficiaries: Children with CP and their families – depending on the amount donated 10 to 100

The aim of this project is to acquire a new small tractor to ensure that we can provide a high standard of service (horse therapy sessions) to the disabled community of the Tervuren area. We have located a tractor that is new but last year's model that the dealer will give us for Euro 9000. To this end we would appreciate a sponsorship of Euro 9000 to purchase the tractor. This tractor would be stored at the arena and used exclusively to maintain the surface for the riding of the disabled patrons.
